

Access Statement

General information

We are committed to providing the best possible service to guests with restricted movement and ability, either before booking or during their stay.

- We welcome assistance dogs throughout the building.
- Sladen Lodge complies with Fire Safety legislation and is regularly inspected by a member of the Fire Service.
- The Fire Alarm is audible only.
- Written emergency evacuation information is provided and can be communicated verbally on request.
- A public bus service is available from the bottom of the driveway and up to date times can be provided on request.
- The nearest train station is Hathersage (10 minutes walk from the Lodge) and collection by car can be arranged.
- An up to date list of taxis is provided in the Guest information pack.
- Assistance with luggage is offered.
- All bedrooms have remote control TV
- All electrical sockets are positioned at the required height.
- There is a landline telephone located in the kitchen for guests use.
- There is good mobile reception for all networks.
- A designated, temperature controlled guest fridge is available for medicine or special food etc.
- We do not allow dogs or cats inside the property.
- We provide synthetic duvets & pillows where guests are allergic to feather & down.

Internal Access

- All bedrooms are on the ground floor and accessed via a level floor surface from the rest of the Lodge.
- All bedroom doors are a contrasting colour from the decoration surrounding them.
- 6 Bedrooms have an en-suite shower room which is level and there is a 10cm shower tray height. There is a wall mounted grab rail in 1 of the shower rooms.
- 1 Bedroom has a 170cm bath (without handrails) with a shower over.
- All bathroom fittings are standard.
- All beds are standard height and 3ft wide. When requested twin beds are made up as a super-king.

External Access

Sladen Lodge is all on one level and although we have tried to ensure it is as accessible as possible it has limitations:

- The driveway is steep but there is space for one car to park adjacent to the front door.
- Access to the front door is via 5 steps and a further 1 step through the front door (see photo left). Alternative level wheelchair access is possible via 1 step at the back door (see photo right)



- The garden and patio can be accessed via the front or back door which both have 1 step.
